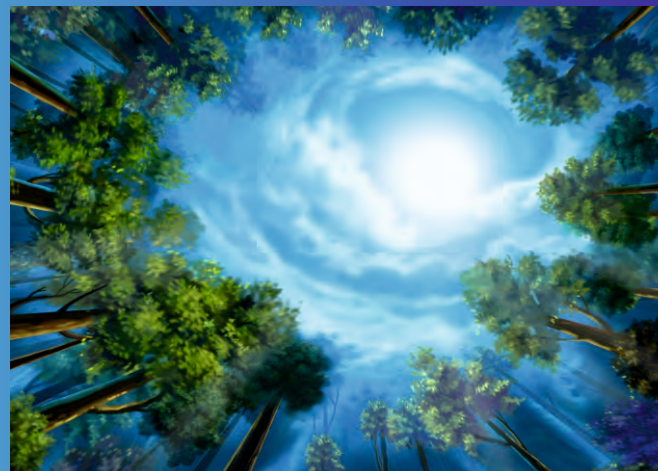

Abstracts accepted for publication will be presented in a volume of conference proceedings.

Requirements for design of the abstracts:

- volume: 3-5 full pages
- .doc or .docx format, MS Word 2007 or an earlier version;
- font: Times New Roman; size: 14 pt.; margins: symmetrical,
- 25 mm; line spacing: 1; indentation: 10 mm
- the text heading should contain:
1st line: title of the report (caps, size:14, bold, center);
2nd line: full name of the speaker (center);
3rd line: full name and academic degree of the scientific adviser (center);
4th line: affiliation with the full name of the University (center).

The deadline for abstract submission is 1 March 2014.

Publication is free of charge.

Forms of participation: intramural / extramural.

Presentations should be MS Power Point 2013 or an earlier version.

Participants of the conference should be in possession of a Passport (International Passport for the CIS member states' citizens)

Accommodation and travel costs are covered on the basis of self-funding and / or other external sponsorships. Participants of the conference should be in possession of a Passport (International Passport for the CIS member states' citizens).



Odessa State Environmental University is the object of state property and an affiliated body of the Ministry of Education and Science, Youth and Sports of Ukraine, the key national educational centre of the IV (highest) level of accreditation for training of specialists in the field of: 'Environmental Science', 'Hydrometeorology', 'Management', 'Computer Science' and 'Water Bio-Resources'

OSENU is the seat of the Standing Commissions of the Ministry of Education and Science, Sport and Youth of Ukraine in the fields of 'Hydrometeorology' and 'Environmental Education and Education for Sustainable Development'

Over a long period the main aim of OSENU (founded in 1932) was to train personnel in the fields of environmental quality monitoring and environmental control. In the field of Hydrometeorology OSENU has been training specialists for the World Meteorological Organization for more than 50 years. The curricula for training specialists meet all international standards and are acknowledged by hydrometeorological services all over the world. Since 1957 the University has provided training for some 1600 specialists from more than 70 countries, including circa 150 Candidates and Doctors of Science. One of the graduates of OSENU, a member of Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, Alioune Ndiaye was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize (2007). For the time being foreign citizens of 27 countries have been provided education at the University.

It is on the basis of the Department of Agricultural Meteorology and Agrometeorological Forecasting and the Department of Applied Environmental Science, a Coordination Center for Training and Retraining of Specialists in Agricultural Meteorology, Agroecology and Climate Change from the CIS countries (a Center of Excellence) is established by the decision of International Coordination Meeting within the framework of the 'Development of Qualification Framework in Meteorology', QualiMet, 159352-TEMPUS-FI-TEMPUS-JPHES), 8 June 2012, Rome (Italy), as a result of the joint actions of the partners under 'EU Based Course in Foodstuff Expertise & Quality Control', EUBCFEQC, 159173-TEMPUS-DE-TEMPUS-JPCR, and 'Environmental Governance for Environmental Curricula', EnGo, 511390-TEMPUS-1-2010-1-SK-TEMPUS-JPCR) projects and with the decisions of the 24th Session of the Intergovernmental Council on Hydrometeorology of the CIS countries, 4-5 October, 2012, Kazan (Russian Federation), taken account of.
